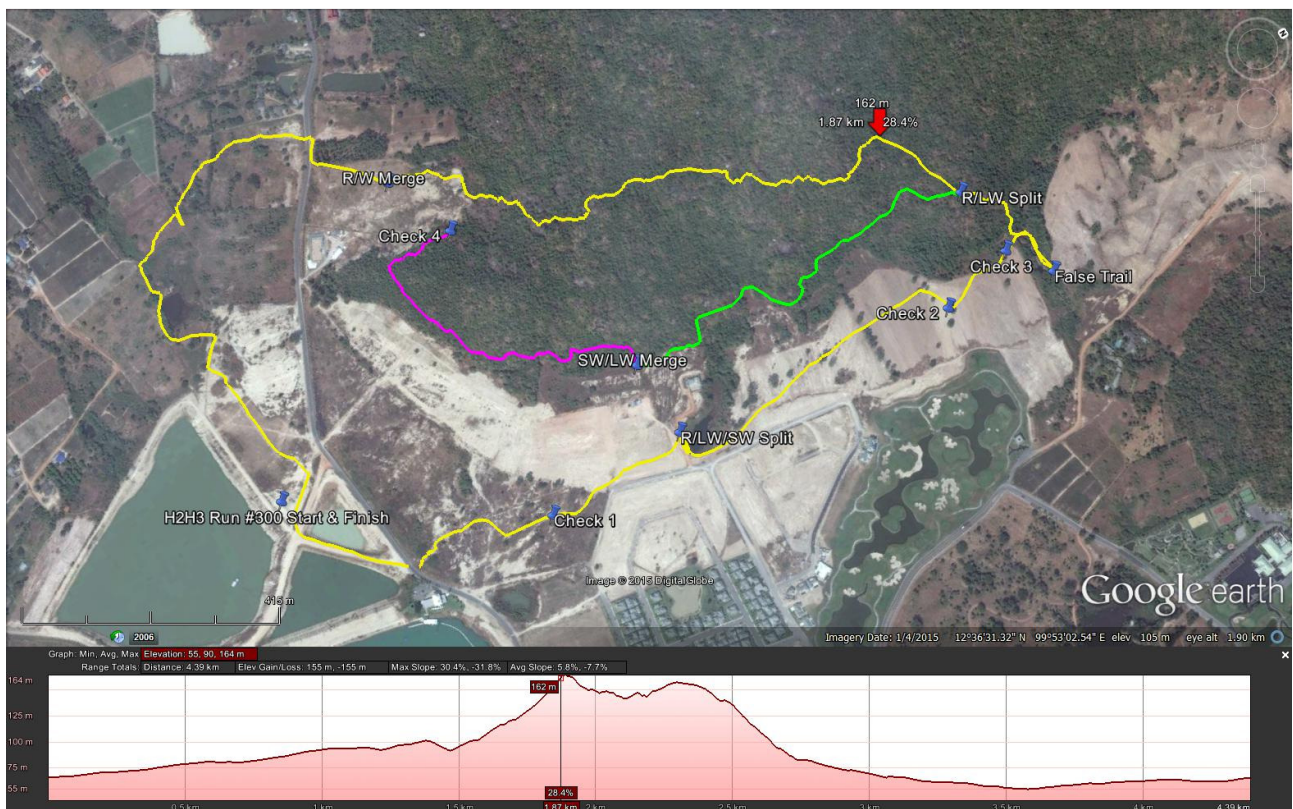
Pre-Hash

It was a clear and hot day for the Hash and the area picked by the Hares was lacking in vegetation of sufficient height to provide any shade. However there was a strong breeze from the south east and several water storage lakes for the nearby Black Mountain Water and Wake Board Park.

Shortly after 15:30 the first hashers arrived and over the next hour the total attendance reached 78. The much awaited 300th Run Polo Shirt was available with the pre-order distribution being handled by Brambles Bill and Golden Delicious.

Tinks ably assisted by Screwdriver addressed the assembled pack of hounds and advised on the days trails, three in all, a short walk, a long walk and a runners/rambos.

The Trail

Green Trail: Long Walk from Runners split to Short Walk Merge

Magenta Trail: Long Walk and Short Walk to Runners Trail

The pack set off towards the Wake Board Park, where the first paper was to be found. Having found paper the runners upped the pace and headed off across scrub land in the direction of the hills to the

first check. From here it was onto the Short Walk split to the left and the long walk/runners to the right.

The long walk/runners then headed north across more open ground with paper hidden in shrubs and at the base of larger trees. The next check had the pack searching in several directions until paper was found and then onto the next check which proved to be a stumbling block for most. By the time both hares had arrived on the scene the check had still not been broken although one false trail had been found. Then a call to the south was heard and all cashed after the caller only to find a second false trail. Complaints were aired about having two false trails on the same check. Eventually the Hares took pity and guided them to look uphill and to the right. Eventually the trail was found and then followed an uphill trail weaving around boulders, bamboo clumps and trees. After a short while the long awaited long split was found and this saw the true runners/rambos break right and continue on upwards. At this point your scribe continued on the long walk with the tail end walkers. The trail meandered along the hillside until eventually merging with the short walk. From here the walkers then continued over rocky ground navigating around trees and bamboo until eventually breaking into more open ground a check. Screwdriver was on hand to see the walkers off in the right direction and to see the runners coming of the hill and merging with the walkers trail and heading in the direction of the road. Most of the pack headed over the road into a greener and flatter environment with a couple of checks before heading back to the start. Some however opted to short cut down the road to the car park.

Upon looking to the start two small figures were observed to be racing across the last 300 metres or so and it was a closely matched race until the last 50 metres when Mudman started to flag and Swindlers Pissed claimed podium honours.
