Pre-Hash and Briefing

The weather was kind again and hashers started to arrive in anticipation of another Head Ball Cock challenge. A few hashers spent time looking for the hash site opposite the Da Vinci school

rather than a little further down the road. As this was to be our Remembrance Day Run it was pleasing to see many of you wearing a Poppy in respect for our fallen Armed Forces Service Members. Prior to the traditional Hash misinformation from the Hares we had a short service of remembrance. Cathusalem opened with the Last Post followed by Jock Twat's reading of The Ode of Remembrance (by Laurence Binyon) followed by a minute's silence and concluded with Cathusalem playing the Rouse.



It was now time for the pre-hash briefing given by Head Ball Cock. No hazards on the trails although they were now more easily negotiable due to some extensive ground cover clearing on the second half of the trail. At the first Rambo /Walker Split there was a hill challenge with the first three to the top able to collect a winning ticket for their efforts. After this both the Walker's trail and a Rambo trail would lead to a viewpoint. Hashers were advised to read the sign at the viewpoint as this would assist them in making the right choice of trail. At 4:30 the pack set off on trail.

The TRAIL

With the pack off on trail, Hare HBC headed off to the hill challenge point to ensure that the walkers went on the correct trail and that the Rambo's completed the challenge before continuing the Rambo trail. In the meantime, Tinks headed to the first check to find Onefer on the false trail having missed the FT sign. Onefer made it back onto the true trail while Tinks took a short cut to arrive at the first Rambo/Walk split before the front runners. Having reminded the Rambo's of the hill challenge and the seeing the Walkers safely on their way Tinks headed out cross country to the Rambo/Walk merge point. Hare HBC headed to the



point where the trail led to the viewpoint and in a position to guide the tail end walkers to the Walker's trail home. Meanwhile the pack that visited the viewpoint either did not read the misdirection or opted to follow others without reading the sign thereby resulting in several walkers ending up on the Rambo trail. Tinks met up with the front runners/walkers and then having seen the last of the hounds through the merge point headed back om a more direct route to the start to enjoy some cold beer.
