Pre-Hash & Briefing

A familiar hash location normally used by Screwdriver and Butt Out. But not today, it was to be Paddy Red Belly and Rubber Duck. We can usually expect wet terrain when these two hares get together but not today with bright blue and cloudless skies, only to be spoilt by a strong and cold wind (definitely in my and Cock in a Frocks case). The Hares PRB & Rd were called in to a pre-hash circle to advise on today's trails. Nothing untoward, paper on the right, checks and maybe false trails. Only two trails, but with a short cut option which would be provided by the hares at the appropriate location. One split but no merge.

The Trail



The pack set off on time and headed west on a clear track before turning right into more overgrown terrain heading in the direction of the temple. Keeping to the right of the temple

the trail followed along a fence line and then turned right and headed alongside a lake. Another



favourite Hash start point. On past the lake and continuing along the gravel road, then right and right again to meet the Hares at the short cut point. Short cut straight on and true trail left with the first 50 metres hugging a barbed wire fence and trying to avoid a wet and muddy path underfoot. The trail headed in the direction of the hills and then turning right to contour round the hill to the run/walk split. Then onto the merge point with the short cut and on home down that same gravel road.

Post run and Circle.

Although the wind had subsided somewhat it was still cold as far as I was concerned so on went the extra clothing. I heard some hashers also saying they forgot to pack winter woollies for



the post run. The beer was well chilled, and Skippy's snacks went down well. As some hashers were feeling the cold and disappearing fast the circle was called and the following Down Downs awarded:
