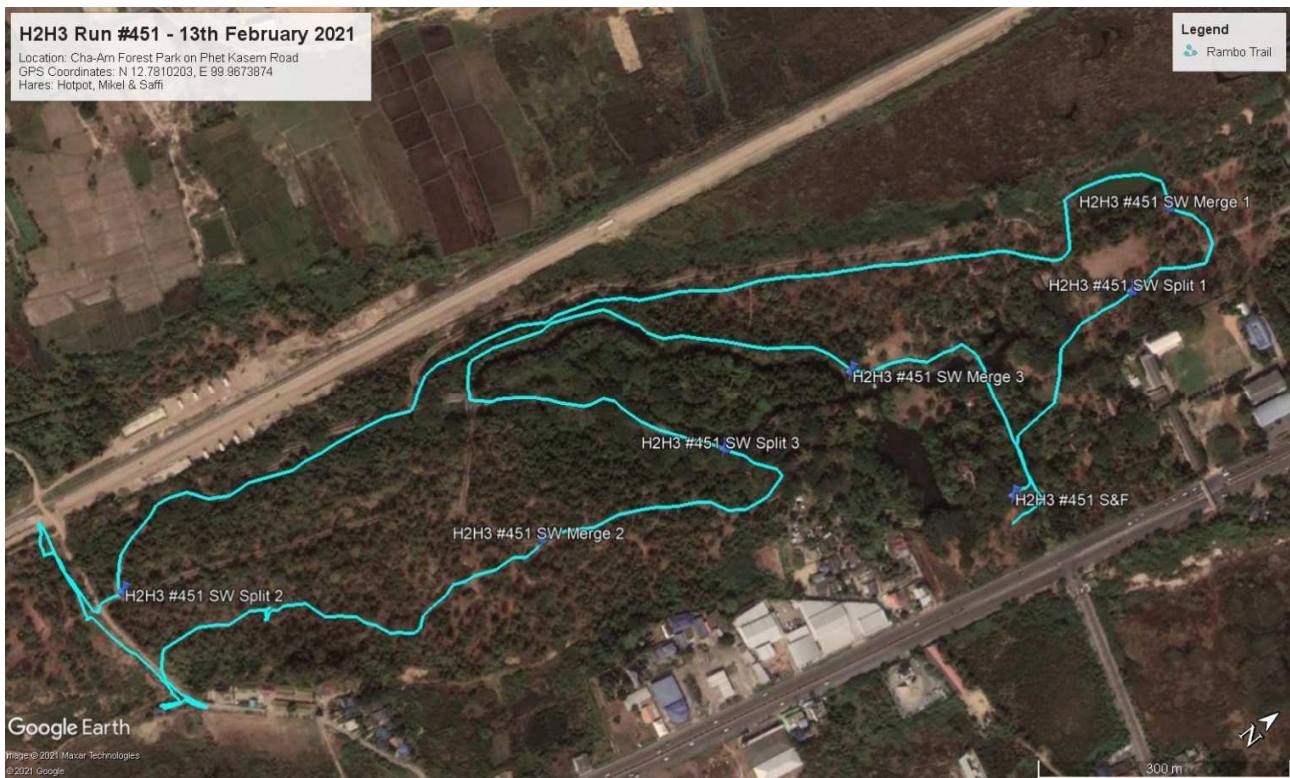
**Pre-Run**

A return to the location of the last hash prior to the 2020 Covid-19 lockdown in March for the Chinese New Year run with trails set by Chinese Hotpot assisted by Virgin Hares Mikel and Saffi. As the hounds arrived Biermeister Jock Twat, still suffering from his near finger amputation, was assisted in setting up the beer box and post hash beverages. Just prior to the pre-run briefing we were advised by a park warden that we had to wear masks upon entry to the park, so a quick return to cars to collect masks. Hotpot advised that today's trail would be environmentally friendly with no paper. Marking on the tarmac sections of the trail would consist of stick chalk circle checks with trail options pointing in various directions and the On On would be marked within 100 m of the checks. Hotpot then handed over the briefing to Virgin Hares Mikel and Saffi to explain the markings on the off-tarmac sections of trail. We would encounter a mixture of stick arrows, piles of coconut chips and red string ties. With everyone fully briefed and with no hazards on route the pack of 46 set off through the park entrance

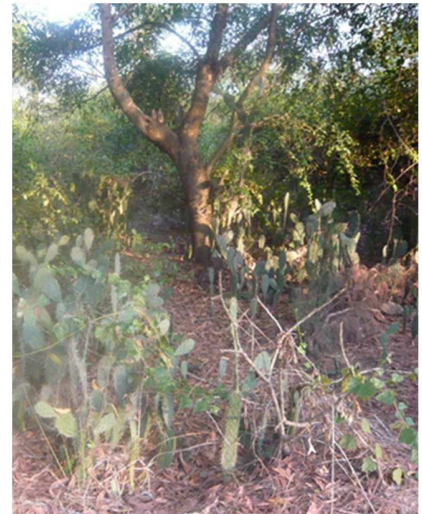


**The Trail**

Shortly after entering the park and crossing over a small bridge the trail went right and to the first Short Walk (SW) split adjacent to the football pitch which everyone missed. From here the trail continued around the outer perimeter of the park with checks at almost every tarmac track junction. Unfortunately, the check options were not cancelled out as none of the FRB's had chalk to mark the correct trail. Upon reaching the southern end of the park there was another SW split with the Rambo's heading out of the park over a barbed wire fence to a check. At this point the FRB's had all disappeared and only walkers remained looking for trail. I went to the railway and found nothing. Onefer mention that he had found one pile of coconut chips but nothing else. As the pack wandered around looking for options towards the East, I reverted to calling Hotpot to get some idea of where the trail went. It apparently re-entered the park shortly after the coconut pile. So, I went back looking and found a narrow track leading back into the park with a stick arrow on the track. Calling the On On the



stranded walkers were now back on trail. The trail wandered through the trees and grass interspersed with cacti. In a few places the trail was a little difficult to find but with many walkers in the group dispersed in several directions we managed to complete the jungle section and rejoin the SW trail. Shortly thereafter we came across SW split 3, with the SW's going right and the Rambo's continuing straight until we came to a confusing check with all options cancelled out and then saw one arrow with word "follow". So, on we marched but it was long while before we found any arrows. Along this stretch we were almost run down by a young boy on a bike followed by his sister on a battery powered scooter, who did sound her hooter to make us aware of her presence. The trail then merged with the SW trail and we headed off along side a small lake to join up with the out trail and return back to the car park.



### **Pre-Circle:**

By the time I returned to the car park all the FRB's and those that found the short walk were well into the beverages. All hashers were back within 75 minutes so a well-judged trail laying. Some complaints about getting caught up in the jungle section of the trail and suffering scratches and torn clothing. Apple Cake prepared by Rubber Scrubber was put on the table along with traditional crisps, but all soon disappeared. Shortly after 6:00 GM Tinks called the pack to order for the post hash circle and down downs issued.
