Pre-Run

A return to a new start location on the familiar road leading to the Banyan Golf Course off Soi 112. The parking areas resemble a slalom course with 900 mm high concrete posts scattered everywhere. Luckily no penalty points were incurred by drivers. As the beer truck was being unloaded hashers arrived and it was looking like a good turnout again for a Ding-a-Ling and Cock in a Frock trail challenge. By the time of calling the pre-run briefing the numbers had reached 47 leaving the traditional late comers Luck Me and Slime to show some 20 minutes after the off.


The hares assisted by Frock with a Cock briefed the gathered pack on the hazards of the trails, Three trails in total, a Short Walk of less than 4 k, a Long Walk of around 5.5 k and a Rambo trail of 6.5+ k. The first Rambo loop was a runners trail and a more scenic route of the walkers trail was recommended. The start would be a little wet for a short distance and thereafter dry. Also on the walkers trail there had been some burn off so the paper would be a little sparse but had been relaid earlier in the day. With no other danger warning the pack set out at 4:30 pm.

The Trail

The pack set off heading west and downhill towards the wet area, which was not so wet. The trail then turned north and after negotiating a barbed wire fence we headed towards Aintree (home of the Grand National). I do not recall the Hares mentioning of any fence hazards and luckily for us they were not electrified. Screwdriver struggled at the first fence but successfully jumped the next two. The trail then led into longer grass and trees



before reaching the Short Walk split. At this point several hashers opted to head back on the short walk led by



Matron wishing to return to his dog which was being dog sat by Dave the Vape and Lilly. From here the FRBs had long gone and so Screwdriver, Saffi, returnee Orange Pippin and I headed out on the Rambo trail leading ahead of any other hounds opting not to take the short walk. Shortly thereafter the trail split with the walk to the left and the Rambo's straight on. At this point Screwdriver set out on the walker's trail while Saffi, OP and I completed the first Rambo loop down to the lake and then on to the merge point where we met up with Screwdriver. The group of four then continued on what was to be the start of a gradual uphill slog to the road and then over and on ever upwards towards the run/walk split. On the way we came across Cock in a Frock who advised that the second run walk split was ahead but offered a short cut to join the short walk home. We all stayed on the main trail to the split and took the walkers trail thus avoiding the Rambo hill loop. From here it was downhill to meet up with the run/walk merge and then heading home



joining up with the short walk merge on route. FRB's African Queen and Hong Ting Tong having completed the hill loop were now behind us as we made our way back to the car park.



Pre-Circle:



The pack were spread out in several groups with the dog owners in one, the sitters in another and the rest in conversational groups discussing among other things the trails and the failure by the hares to announce about the fence challenges. Cock in a Frock was having a neck extension over the fact that Cathusalem had opted to take the Hill Loop but this proved to be wrong. Cathusalem had gone astray at the road crossing but did get back on trail and completed the long walk. Slime and Lucky Me by tradition arrived after the pack had departed but completed the full trail and confirmed that Cathusalem was not that far behind. Around 6:15 the post run circle was called to order and the following punishments/awards given:
