

Pre-Run

With the increased Covid-19 cases in Hua Hin a decision was made Friday morning to go ahead with the hash with a request for masking and social distancing. As part of the social distancing the beer box was cancelled and hashers were requested to bring their own beverage, water and snacks. In view of this change the number of attendees was lower than expected with the more hardy hashers showing, a total of 28 altogether. As there was no beerbox or snacks hash taxes were waved. As 5:0 pm approached the pack were called to order and the Hares, African Queen, Hong Ting Tong and assistant Head Ballcock were invited to advise on any particular on trail hazards. There were three trails, a short walk, a long walk and a rambo trail. The pack could expect some long grass, water hazards but no nasty dogs, cattle or barbed wire. Trail markings as usual and maybe the odd false trail. As I was still recovering from a soft tissue infection in my left foot I rested up together with family.

The Trail
